Missing Leave Reports – Summer 2015

- There are 1,400 missing leave reports from Summer 2015.
 - A common mistake is that the employee enters the No Leave Taken on the primary record instead of the summer record.
 - AM will be sending a list identifying the employees with No Leave Taken on their primary record with instructions on how to adjust them to their summer record.



Missing Leave Report in Cypress

- The Missing Leave Report was delivered to Cypress this month, however, it is pulling current month in error. The report is showing that April is missing.
- Best option is to continue to run the report adhoc.
- AM will be including in their communication a report of all missing leave reports through March 2016 of this fiscal year.



EJED Mass Job Update

This weekend, on May 7th, the Service Center will extend employee's EJED via a mass job update who are marked with a "Y" on the spreadsheets submitted.

Employees who are marked with a "N", to not extend the EJED, will be terminated through the normal expected job end date processing for the May payroll on May 19^{th.}

 as the submissions are evaluated. Our aim is to balance the program for HR, Financials, Campus Solutions, Reporting and
 Technology.
