Sick Leave Credit Conversion Training

The Department of Employee Trust Funds (ETF) conducted Sick Leave Credit Conversion Program training in July. A series of four (4) recorded webinars is now available on ETF's website at [Employer Training](#).

- Module 1 - Overview of the sick leave program, eligibility requirements and sick leave conversion credit calculations.
- Module 2 – Employer/employee responsibilities and when to certify sick leave.
- Module 3 – Rehired annuitants, sick leave escrow, sick leave re-enrollment process and what happens in the event of death.
- Module 4 - Employer Resources and Q&A from in-person training.
