Loss of Medicaid

Due to the end of the public health emergency on May 11, 2023, the state of Wisconsin has started to reevaluate Medicaid participant eligibility. This means that some participants may lose their Medicaid coverage.

The loss of Medicaid is a qualifying life event that would allow an employee to enroll in the State Group Health Insurance Program, during a limited enrollment window based on when their Medicaid coverage ends.

- If they lose Medicaid coverage **prior to** June 10, 2023, they have until **July 10, 2023** to enroll (**60 days** after the end of the public health emergency).
- If they lose Medicaid coverage **on or after** June 10, 2023, they have the normal **30-day** enrollment window.

Loss of Medicaid

If an employee indicates they involuntarily lost their Medicaid coverage, obtain the below from the employee.

- A completed State Group Health Insurance application
- Documentation that shows when their Medicaid coverage ended
